ST. THOMAS HAPPENINGS

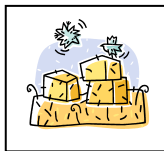
ALL SAINTS' DAY- Tuesday, Nov. 1st

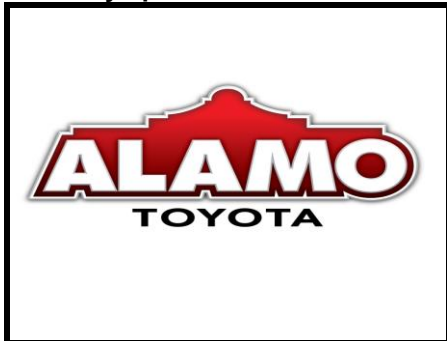
MARKET DAY – FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11TH

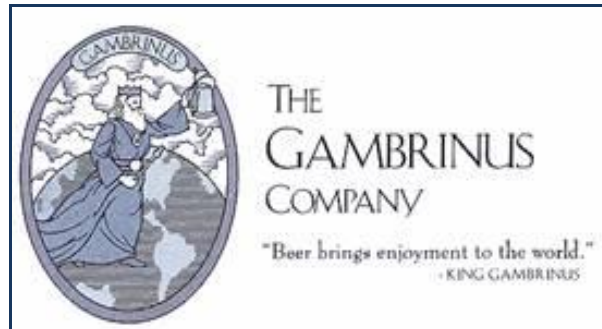
